## PENN RECEPTION AT AIA CHICAGO - JUNE 11

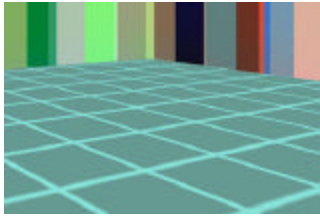
