

City and Regional Planning Certificate Programs

The Department offers a certificate program whose purpose is two-fold. First, it provides a mechanism whereby students may concentrate on one of the fields of planning practice during the course of their degree program. Second, practicing professionals with prior graduate training in urban planning may learn about recent developments in their principal field of interest or prepare for a planning career in a new area of specialization.

The areas of certification are: Community and Economic Development; Environmental Planning and Growth Management; Transportation and Infrastructure Systems Planning; Urban Design; and Urban and Regional Information Systems.
