Abstract: The collection comprises architectural drawings and photomechanical prints

documenting buildings and projects of Cope & Stewardson and its successor firm Stewardson and Page spanning the years 1890-1929. The fullest holdings are for buildings on the campus of the University of Pennsylvania. The collection also includes later drawings of Robert Rodes McGoodwin and Trautwein & Howard for additions to projects by Cope & Stewardson and Stewardson and Page.

Biographical/Historical Sketch

Cope & Stewardson, established in 1885, was one of the most important scholastic architecture firms in the United States at the end of the nineteenth and the beginning of the twentieth centuries, and are particularly known for their work in Collegiate Gothic mode. Founders Walter Cope (1860-1902) and John Stewardson (1858-1896) used their prominent Quaker family connections to get their earliest important commissions at Haverford and Bryn Mawr Colleges in 1886, but their talent soon brought them to the attention of many other institutional and private clients in Philadelphia and beyond. Their work at the University of Pennsylvania was a watershed in the work of the firm and in the West Philadelphia campus of the school: they were hired by Provost Charles Custis Harrison to create a residential campus that would engender a vital undergraduate experience, using the Oxbridge model as inspiration. Their first work at Penn, the Dormitory Quadrangle (begun 1894) was followed by a series of buildings that set the architectural palette for the campus. Their important campus work also included Washington University in St. Louis (begun 1899).

Both of the firm's principals died untimely deaths: John Stewardson drowned in a skating accident in 1896 and Walter Cope succumbed to a stroke in 1902. The office's original name was continued by Emlyn Stewardson (who had joined the firm in 1887), John's brother, until 1912, when George B. Page was made a partner in Stewardson & Page. This firm continued with a significant practice until 1936.

Scope and Content Note

The Cope & Stewardson Collection comprises architectural drawings and photomechanical prints documenting buildings and projects of Cope & Stewardson and its successor firm Stewardson and Page. The most numerous drawings are construction drawings, but the collection includes fine examples of design and presentation drawings. Among these is a presentation drawing of the Quadrangle Dormitories, ca. 1894, signed by Charles Z. Klauder. A clipping of that drawing with an accompanying article from Harper's Weekly (date not found) is the only clipping in the collection. The collection does not contain any photographs, specifications or correspondence, nor is there any documentation for the teaching activities or personal lives of any members of the firms. The fullest holdings in this collection are drawings for buildings on the campus of the University of Pennsylvania, which were transferred to the Architectural Archives by the Department of Buildings and Grounds.

The collection includes documentation for some later alterations and additions to buildings designed by Cope & and Stewardson and Stewardson and Page for the University of Pennsylvania. Most important are drawings (1946) for Robert Rodes McGoodwin's addition to the North Wing of the Veterinary Medicine Old Quadrangle and drawings (1953-1958) for Trautwein & Howard's final section of the Quadrangle Dormitories, which completed the quadrangle envisioned by Cope & Stewardson in 1894. In this connection it is noteworthy that Trautwein & Howard was a successor firm to Day and Klauder, whose partner Charles Z. Klauder had drawn in his youth Cope& Stewardson's 1894 presentation drawing. In addition, because the drawings by Cope & and Stewardson and Stewardson and Page were for many years actively used by the University of Pennsylvania Department of Buildings and Grounds, there are many later markings on original drawings and on blueprints. There are also a small number of later additional sheets for minor alterations; any such later sheets have been housed with the drawings for the building in question.

The collection does not include any drawings for buildings on any other college or university campus. Other projects represented in the collection include hospitals, commercial buildings and houses. Researchers working on the architecture of Samuel Sloan may be interested in a set of 1926 survey drawings of existing buildings at Episcopal Hospital, Philadelphia, most of which have since been demolished. Also noteworthy are two Philadelphia commercial buildings designed for Charles Custis Harrison in 1893, before he became Provost of the University.

The collection is arranged in three series. Series I contains buildings on the campus of the University of Pennsylvania. Series II contains projects of Cope & Stewardson not on the Penn campus. Series III contains projects of Stewardson and Page not on the Penn campus. With the exception of a class memorial and a fraternity house, the University is the client for all the works in Series I. It should be noted that Series II contains another project (off campus) for the same fraternity.

A fourth series will in the future contain additional groups of drawings for Cope & Stewardson or Stewardson and Page projects on the campus of the University of Pennsylvania.

Appendix A is an index of firms and their projects represented in the collection. Each project is associated with a job number assigned by the firm, if available. A project for which the job number is unknown is indicated by the job number xxx. Each project entry specifies project title, client name, span dates of materials, notes, and holdings in each series.

Appendix B is an index of University of Pennsylvania buildings represented in the collection, listed alphabetically by the current (2000) name of the building. Each building entry specifies firm names and job numbers of materials in the collection.
