General Computing Information:

While Fine Arts students are not absolutely required to have a personal computer, it is strongly recommended that you own one for your expected needs for the two years of your MFA study. A personal computer would not only support your academic and creative work, especially for those whose art is digitally or computationally focused, but it would be of service to you for several years beyond your graduation. Having a personal computer is an investment that would greatly enhance your studies and your post-graduate professional path.

Ordering Information:

Should you choose to order a computer through the University's preferred vendors, you can log into <u>Campus Express</u> (Beginning June 1st) to order your device. It is important that you secure your computer and other peripherals with lock down kits. If you plan to purchase a system elsewhere, or want to evaluate a system you already own, please contact <u>ithelp@design.upenn.edu</u> and someone form the IT staff will be able to consult with you. We encourage students to place their technology order as quickly as possible. Current circumstances have disrupted some supply chainswhich can cause longer shipping and delivery times.

Software:

While many software programs are available in computer labs for your use, you are highly encouraged to obtain a subscription to Adobe Creative Cloud. You can subscribe to the educationally discounted Adobe Creative Cloud subscription at https://www.adobe.com/creativecloud/buy/students.html.

Free:

Financing:

If you are a US citizen or permanent resident, have filed a FAFSA form, and are eligible for Federal loans, you can ask for a budget increase from the University's Office of Student Financial Services to assist you in the purchase of your computer.
