- When you're graduating and have a job: fill out our survey!


Services for graduate students




2017 CAREER PLANS SURVEY REPORT FOR PENNDESIGN

METHODOLOGY

The following is based on Penn Career Services' annual survey of graduating School of Design students. Between September 2016 and December 2017, Career Services surveyed students graduating in August 2016, December 2016, and May 2017. Of the 277 PennDesign graduates from this period who received the survey, 131 students responded - a 47% Response Rate - and information about 43 other students was gleaned from LinkedIn and other online sources by Career Services staff, resulting in a 63% overall Knowledge Rate.

EMPLOYMENT STATUS - ALL RESPONDENTS








HISTORIC PRESERVATION


LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE


URBAN SPATIAL ANALYTICS

DATE OF JOB OFFER

Information about date of job offer was gathered for all 149 students who have secured full- or part-time employment. 79% of these students received their offer within 2 months of their graduation date.


