Encryption – Encryption protects your data in the event that your machine or hard drive is
lost/stolen or tampered with, in which case a recovery key is needed to unlock the drive. If
you lose your recovery key and become locked out of your computer, there is no way to
access/recover data – you must re-install your Operating System in this case. Windows
includes BitLocker encryption; macOS includes FileVault2 for encryption.
Windows allows you to save your BitLocker recovery key to a file or a Microsoft
account. Students must not use their PennO365 Microsoft Account for this
purpose. It is recommended to save the key to a personal Microsoft Account or to
an external hard drive/USB drive, or print the key and store it in a secure location.
