**WAIVERS:**

Waiver of required courses is uncommon, but possible for some students. Fall registration must be finalized by the end of the drop/add period, September 14.

Waived credit-bearing courses must be replaced by LARP elective courses. The substitution does not need to occur during the same term as the waived course, but by the time that you graduate from the program, you must have completed the same total number of LARP credits as required by the curriculum that you are following.
