Abstract: The Ian L. McHarg collection comprises materials related to his position as the founder and chairman of the Landscape Architecture Department at the University of Pennsylvania, materials associated with his lectures, publications, and professional projects, and other professional and personal papers. The collection contains extensive holdings related to the evolution of the principals of ecological planning, together with related teaching records, publications and films. Holdings related to his professional projects are limited by comparison, and the collection contains only a small amount of personal material.

Biographical/Historical Sketch

Ian L. McHarg, born in Clydebank, Scotland in 1920, was the founder and chairman of the department of Landscape Architecture at the University of Pennsylvania, pioneer of ecological planning, author of *Design With Nature* and co-founder of the firm Wallace, McHarg, Roberts and Todd. He served in World War Two as a paratrooper and demobilized at the rank of major in the British military. He received his professional education from Harvard University, earning a Master in Landscape Architecture in 1950 and a Master of City Planning in 1951.

McHarg was brought to the University of Pennsylvania by G. Holmes Perkins to re-establish the Department of Landscape Architecture in 1954. His ecological approach based upon the “layer cake method” of mapping revolutionized the field of landscape architecture both at the University of Pennsylvania and across the United States. McHarg’s influence can also be seen in the development of geographic information systems, which utilize the same “layer cake method” developed in his teaching. He was a key proponent of a world ecological inventory to integrate data sets already present in organizations around the world to produce a world ecological model. His groundbreaking book *Design With Nature* disseminated his concept of ecological planning to an international audience making his ideas the foundation for many landscape architecture programs across the United States and beyond.

McHarg chaired the Department of Landscape Architecture at the University of Pennsylvania from its founding until his retirement in 1986, and continued to teach as emeritus professor until 1999. Beginning in 1959, he developed a revolutionary course “Man and the Environment” which employed interdisciplinary research to obtain a better understanding of the human relationship to the natural world. For this course McHarg invited experts from a variety of different fields to lecture to his students on (in his words) “scientific conceptions of matter, life and man; the views of God, man, and nature in the major philosophies and religions, and, last, an examination of the interaction of man and nature, mainly ecological.” He continued to teach this course to succeeding generations of students during the following decades. He also adapted the course lecture format into the television interview series *The House We Live In*, focusing on the “evolution of matter, life and man.” McHarg conducted interviews with specialists in a wide variety of fields, some of whom were important figures in 20th century thought. The series, originally broadcast on CBS in the early 1960s, was later rebroadcast on PBS.

McHarg and his Harvard classmate David Wallace founded the design firm Wallace-McHarg Associates in 1962, commissioned by the Green Spring and Worthington Valley Planning Council to address the threat to the valleys by urban expansion of metropolitan Baltimore. Renamed Wallace, McHarg, Roberts and Todd in 1965, this design firm led the fields of city planning, urban design and landscape architecture during the 1970s by approaching design from an ecological perspective. Significant projects include the “Inner Harbor Master Plan” for Baltimore, Maryland, “A Comprehensive Landscape for Washington D.C.” and “Woodlands New Community” in Houston, Texas. McHarg established his own practice after his resignation from the firm in 1979.

McHarg was honored with numerous awards and medals, including the Harvard Lifetime Achievement Award, the National Medal of Art, the Thomas Jefferson Foundation Medal in Architecture and the Pioneer Award from the American Institute of Certified Planners. In April 2000, he received the Japan Prize in city planning. Ian McHarg died on March 5, 2001, at the age of 80.

Scope and Content Note

The Ian L. McHarg Collection comprises the contents of his remarkably intact late-career office, received by the Architectural Archives during the summer of 2000. Located on the fourth floor of Meyerson Hall on the University of Pennsylvania campus, McHarg's office and its contents reflected his life's work as a pioneer of environmental thinking and education. The collection contains extensive holdings related to the development of principles of ecological planning, with related teaching records, publications and films. Holdings related to his professional projects are limited by comparison, and the collection contains only a small amount of personal material.

The bulk of the materials in the collection date from 1954-1999, the period in which he founded, chaired and taught in the Department of Landscape Architecture and Regional Planning of the University of Pennsylvania. The collection is arranged in five series: I Personal papers; II Professional papers; III Project records; IV Materials donated to the Architectural Archives by Frederick Steiner; and V Materials removed from the first four series for special storage.

Series I comprises a limited quantity of McHarg's personal papers, including documents related to his education at Harvard and early professional experience in Scotland. The travel journal of his first wife, Pauline, written during their late 1940s summer trip across the United States, is particularly valuable for understanding Ian McHarg outside the professional sphere. Also of interest is McHarg's *Report on Destruction and Repairs to Apulian Aqueduct* (1943), which documents his work repairing aqueducts in Italy during World War II. School notebooks from his time at Harvard University and documents from his early research in Scotland offer insights into the origin and development of the principles which shaped his life's work. A small number of personal photographs of McHarg throughout his career are found in Series V. At the end of his life, McHarg taught a course at the University of Pennsylvania focusing on his role in the development of human ecological planning method. Slides he assembled for this course (images of both his personal and professional life) are preserved in their original order in Series V.

Series II comprises McHarg's professional papers, including materials from the University of Pennsylvania, materials related to his research and writings and other correspondence. McHarg's files as received included four discernable alphabetical files, with the largest number of files in no discernable order. In processing an attempt was made to maintain or restore original order in the alphabetical files where possible, and also to organize the remaining materials for practical access. This required considerable refileing within and among established alphabetical files, establishment of additional subseries, and removal of a number of file folders from alphabetical files to more useful locations. This series contains seven subseries: alphabetical files (II.A); major publications, broadcasts and motion pictures (II.B), lectures and articles (II.C); handwritten notes (II.D); teaching (II.E); awards (II.F); and associations and committees (II.G).

The alphabetical files (II.A) are in four sections, labeled during processing Correspondence to 1974, Correspondence after 1974, Alumni Correspondence and Speaking Engagements. The first two are not strict correspondence files, as McHarg regularly filed various papers in with his correspondence. Notable correspondents include Lewis Mumford, G. Holmes Perkins and Lawrence Halprin. Researchers seeking information about McHarg's speaking engagements should consult the first two alphabetical files as well as the fourth alphabetical file in this subseries. Researchers investigating the development of the department of Landscape Architecture and Regional Planning at the University of Pennsylvania will need to consult the first two alphabetical files as well as those in subseries II.E. Researchers interested in McHarg's later professional projects may need to browse the first two

alphabetical files as well as those in Series III. Researchers looking for information about a particular project should use caution because McHarg did not use a uniform system for naming his folders, sometimes titling them with project names, or geographical locations or names of clients or agents. The final two alphabetical files in subseries II.A contain correspondence with department alumni, the bulk after 1980, and correspondence related to Ian McHarg's speaking engagements from 1962-1993.

Subseries II.B documents McHarg's major publications, broadcasts and motion pictures, especially *Design With Nature* (1969), *The House We Live In* (1960-1961) and *Multiply and Subdue the Earth* (1969). Some materials related to *A Quest for Life* (1996) and *To Heal the Earth* (1998) are found in this subseries, but the bulk of the documentation for these is found in Series IV. This subseries contains comprehensive documentation of all aspects of publication for *Design With Nature*, including preliminary chapter drafts, organizational layouts, outlines, reviews and editorial correspondence. Proposed designs for the cover prepared by McHarg for *Design With Nature* are found in Series V. Transcripts of the television program *The House We Live In* were later edited and reproduced on a small scale. Some preparations for formal publication were made, but the interviews were never formally published. This subseries contains documentation of the editing process for a number of the interviews, as well as most of the interviews in final form. Subseries II.C comprises typescripts and documents related to McHarg's other professional writings both published and unpublished, including papers presented at conferences and articles he submitted for publication. As his teaching and writings frequently overlapped, some handouts distributed to students in the courses he taught at the University of Pennsylvania may also be found here. For articles and lectures in their published form see Series V Published Materials.

Subseries II.E contains materials related to the University of Pennsylvania, including administrative files, materials related to McHarg's courses, and student work dating from 1956 to 1998. Of special note, this subseries documents guest lectures in McHarg's "Man and Environment" course. The following lecturers are represented by typed transcripts or manuscript lecture notes (in McHarg's handwriting): Robert J. Also of special note, this subseries contains one of the few known versions of Aldo Van Eyck's unpublished book, *The Child the City and the Artist: An Essay on Architecture the Inbetween Realm*, which he wrote during his time as Research Staff at the University of Pennsylvania from 1960-1964. Slides and audiovisual materials related to this subseries are found in Series V, specifically presentations given by students about locations under study, including Manayunk, Medford, and the Delaware River Basin. Also in Series V is a videotaped interview of McHarg for the 250th Anniversary of the University of Pennsylvania, where he gives a concise summation of his early work at Penn.

Series III contains documentation related to McHarg's professional projects. Early projects before the founding of Wallace, McHarg, Roberts and Todd are not substantially documented in this collection with the exception of the Woodland Avenue project completed for the University of Pennsylvania in 1959. The collection includes some records of projects completed by McHarg while he was a member of the firm Wallace, McHarg, Roberts and Todd (WMRT) from its founding in 1962 until his resignation in 1979, but largely in the form of bound reports. See Series V for slides documenting some of McHarg's WMRT projects that are not found in Series III. Other collections in The Architectural Archives are also useful for WMRT projects, especially design drawings delineated by Thomas Todd in the Thomas A. Todd Collection. McHarg's later projects, completed after his resignation from WMRT, are documented with correspondence in this series and related architectural drawings and slides in Series V. McHarg's projects represented in this collection are indexed in Appendix A. Researchers should browse Series II for possible additional correspondence related to professional projects, as Series II is not indexed in Appendix A.

Series IV comprises documents related to the publication of *A Quest for Life* and *To Heal the Earth*, donated to the Architectural Archives by Frederick Steiner, a colleague and former student of McHarg who facilitated the publication of both of these books, as an editor in charge of images and managing editor respectively. The series contains preliminary drafts, correspondence and images. Also found are a number of WMRT reports. See also Series II.A for correspondence with Frederick Steiner, and II.B for a small amount of additional material.

Series V contains photographic, audio-visual, oversized and published materials that have been separated from other series for storage. A number of highlights are noted in the series descriptions above. Also notable in this series are three portrait drawings: two by Ian McHarg (one a self-portrait) and one by Sir Peter Shephard. Subseries V.D comprises a selection of the books in McHarg's office at the time the collection was received. See Appendix B for a comprehensive list of all of the books, reports and other published material found in his office at that time.

In processing this collection and preparing the finding aid, Architectural Archives staff have depended heavily on Ian McHarg, *A Quest For Life*. New York: John Wiley and Sons, 1996. McHarg's words quoted in the biographical sketch above are from this source.
