Abstract: The Norman Day Collection comprises planning reports related to Day's professional practice, and teaching and administrative materials from the University of Pennsylvania Graduate School of Fine Arts. The collection also contains a small amount of biographical material.

**Biographical/Historical Sketch**

Norman Day was born in Wayzata, Minnesota and grew up on a farm. He earned a bachelor's degree in architecture from the University of Minnesota before his military service. He earned the MArch from MIT in 1958 and studied at the University of London 1959-1960 on a Fulbright scholarship.

On his return to the United States, he became Assistant Professor of Architecture at the University of Illinois (1960-1963). While in Chicago, he received a Graham Foundation fellowship for 1962-1963 and served as consultant to the City of Chicago Department of City Planning 1962-1964. From 1963 to 1966 in Minneapolis / Saint Paul, he served as Director of the Physical Planning and Design Section of the Twin Cities Metropolitan Planning Commission, during its Joint Land Use and Transportation Planning Program.

In 1966, Day joined the faculty of the University of Pennsylvania Graduate School of Fine Arts as Associate Professor of Architecture and City Planning. He became Chairman of the Urban Design Program in 1968, succeeding David A. Crane. Day's research included an extensive analysis of the methodology of metropolitan planning and evaluation which resulted in an important publication, *Metropolitan Plan Making* (with David E. Boyce and Chris McDonald, 1970).

In addition to his teaching, Day served as consultant to the Philadelphia City Planning Commission 1967-1969 and Niagara Frontier Transportation Authority (Buffalo, NY) 1969-1970. He became Director of the newly established planning and development division of the Kling Partnership, Kling Planning in 1970. From 1977 to 1984, Day was a principal in the partnership Kopple Sheward & Day. He returned to private practice under the name Norman Day Associates, and in January 2002 he joined his firm with McCormick, Taylor & Associates.

Day combined teaching and professional practice throughout his career. He continued to teach and practice until shortly before his death of cancer at age 69 in July 2002.

## Scope and Content Note

This collection is the primary archive of the professional work of Norman Day. The collection comprises planning reports, teaching and administrative files, biographical materials and teaching slides.

**Series I: Planning reports** is divided into two groups: reports produced with Day's participation and reports kept for reference and teaching. Day's own reports include projects undertaken by Kling Planning, Kopple Sheward & Day and Norman Day Associates, as well as a number of Days' early planning projects. Reports kept for reference have been arranged by project location.

**Series II. University of Pennsylvania** contains Day's teaching and administrative files, a rich resource for researchers investigating the planning and urban design programs in the Graduate School of Fine Arts. Materials range from 1966 to 2000, heavily weighted from 1979 to 1985. Courses taught by Day are best represented, but courses taught by his colleagues are also found. Administrative materials include brochures and draft publications containing biographical sketches of several members of the GSFA staff. Also of interest is a directory of students and faculty of the Urban Design Program 1956-1986, edited by Jon Lang and published in 1987. Day's files include a small group of articles (offprints, clippings, photocopies) by his colleagues and others in the field. A 1968 curriculum revision study and a series of brochures produced in the 1980s provide evidence of changing philosophy and practice in the planning and urban design programs.

**Series III. Biographical materials** contains materials related to his education, his writings and his firms. Undergraduate and graduate level papers and a small amount of material from Day's study in England are found here, as is his only architectural design project in the collection: a house design which was awarded first place in the Indianapolis Home Show Architectural Competition in 1960 and published in its 50 Selected House Designs. A selection of Day's publications, including *Metropolitan Plan Making*, is also found in this series. Researchers investigating planning education and educators should note the unabridged 1960 Cranbrook seminar papers which were published in edited form by Day in 1960 and by Marcus Whiffen in 1966. This series contains promotional publications produced by Day's firms, containing biographical information on members of the firms and also information on the philosophy and projects of the firms. Of particular interest is a group related to Kling Planning (with a few items related to other branches of the Kling Partnership). One item titled *New Community Design and Development*, is described as "a research monograph" produced under Day's direction.
