Come hear Randall Mason, Associate Professor and Chair of the Graduate Program in Historic Preservation at the University of Pennsylvania School of Design, talk about the graduate programs at PennDesign, the future of historic preservation, and the extensive portfolio of faculty-student research projects at PennPreservation.

Professor Mason's work includes books, reports, essays and professional projects on urban conservation, urban history and preservation theory in cities across the globe. In 2012-13, he was the recipient of the National Endowment for the Arts Rome Prize at the American Academy in Rome.

LigoranoReese will speak about their current exhibit, *IAMI*, an interactive, fiber-optic tapestry self-portrait that uses personal data gathered from the internet to create fiber-optic tapestry 'threads.'
