Abstract: The collection comprises 111 architectural drawings documenting 17 projects, 1946-

1974, by Beryl Price, architect. All projects represented in the collection are located in the Philadelphia region of Pennsylvania. The collection also includes one student drawing completed (ca. 1932) while Price was a student at the University of

Pennsylvania. The collection does not include project files or photographic materials.

Biographical/Historical Sketch

Beryl Price was born in Philadelphia on November 30, 1910, son of David and Fannie (Bearint) Price. He began his study of architecture at South Philadelphia High School for Boys and proceeded to professional architectural training at the University of Pennsylvania. After he received his B.Arch. in 1933, he worked for architects Simon & Simon (1928-1930) and Philip H. Johnson (1931-1933). In 1936 he was awarded a teaching certificate by the University of Pennsylvania's School of Education and the City of Philadelphia to teach vocational architecture in high school. In 1938, he opened his own architectural office.

During World War II, Price served on the War Production Board's Construction Division as a Senior Engineer, supervising and approving material requests. After the war, Price resumed his practice in Philadelphia, and later opened additional offices in Florida and New Jersey.

Scope and Content Note

The collection comprises 111 architectural drawings documenting 17 projects, 1946-1974, by Beryl Price, architect. All projects represented in the collection are located in Pennsylvania, most in the Philadelphia region. The collection also includes one student drawing completed (ca. 1932) while Price was a student at the University of Pennsylvania, during the tenure of Paul Philippe Cret as Professor of Design. The collection does not include project files or photographic materials.

Projects are arranged in alphabetical order using short project names devised by the Architectural Archives. A project for a personal client is named using the surname of the client, e.g., Pearl Residence.
