
What does ISSS do?

Immigration Services










Each student is assigned an ISSS advisor.

Your advisor is the first person you should turn to with immigration-related inquiries. You can see who your advisor is by checking iPenn. **ISSS offers virtual advising.** You can make a virtual advising appointment in iPenn.



Immigration Services

Immigration document processing





ISSS issues and processes documents needed for immigration, travel, employment (OPT/CPT), and other purposes.

iPenn is the ISSS portal to submit document requests by filling out the corresponding e-form.

I-20 Application Process

- 1. An ISSS email: a limited access PIN and application instructions
 - 2. Your 9-digit Admission ID (provided by your Admissions Office) or US SSN
 - 3. A copy of your passport page: with your name, birthdate, citizenship and expiration date.
 - 4. Required Financial documentation: Need to be less than a year old, in English or with English translation)





I 20 Processing time

- 1. Approximately 3 weeks.
- 2. ISSS is operating remotely until further notice.
- 3. You can check the status of your application in <u>iPenn</u>.



Visa



- 1. Where? An US embassy or consulate in your home country.
- 2. When? Visa can be issued up to 120 days in advance of your course of study start date.

 - 4. Administrative processing (Security Advisory Opinion (SAO)? –
 - ----delayed by more than 180 days, ISSS will contact the US consular post



SEVIS Transfer



- 1.log into iPenn
- 2. choose "Yes" to SEVIS Transfer
- 3. Follow the instructions on the Transfer In Request Form.
 - 4. The I-20/DS-2019 will be created for you once:
 - A. ISSS has received your I-20/DS-2019 Application
 - B. The Transfer In Request Form has been completed and
 - C. After the SEVIS record is released to Penn by your current institution.
- Within 15 days of the program start date listed on your I-20/DS-2019, please complete the arrival form in iPenn.

When can I enter the US?

Within 30 days of the program start date on your I20

CPT or OPT

CPT


- Curricular practical training
- Need to register for a CPT course
- Can only do while before your Penn program end date
- Approved by academic department and ISSS (1-2 weeks)
- Use less than 12 months, won't take away OPT

OPT

- Option practical training
- No need to register for a course
- Pre-completion and Postcompletion
- Approved by the USCIS (2-4 months)
- 1 year
