## **Z6200 Specs. (ADDM\_MATTE, ADDM\_SATIN)**

ADDM\_Matte has HP Super Heavy Weight Coated Matte paper

ADDM\_Satin has HP Instant Dry Satin paper

Roll media size - up to 41" wide

**Minimum border is 0.5", full bleed printing is not available**

**Cost: \$1.50** per square foot for ADDM\_Matte, **\$1.75** per square foot for ADDM\_Satin

→ Be sure to maximize your paper use, you will be charged for a 41" width print




# Z6200 Inkjet Printing with a Color-Managed Workflow (Illustrator)

1. Launch Adobe Illustrator Software

**File > New**

Size your Art Board to the desired paper size. The smallest dimension cannot exceed 41" wide. *Be sure to utilize the full 41" width of the paper because you will be charged for it.*

Choose "More Settings" to set the Raster Effect, no larger than 300 PPI



2. Place your files

Click on the artboard to set your image. You can rotate your image or place additional images to maximize your paper use




3. Select Printer and Media Size options

Select **ADDM-MATTE** for Matte Surface Paper (\$1.00/) or **ADDM-SATIN** for Satin Surface Paper (\$1.50/)

The “Media Size” is the paper size. Select “Custom” from the drop down menu. Set the width and height to the size of your Art Board



Orientation: If you are not seeing the correct orientation of your art board after setting the custom paper size, choose the correct orientation here.



4. Choose **Page Setup** (Bottom Left)


Select Manage Custom Sizes. If you don't see the correct paper size, create a Custom paper size.

Choose OK




5. Choose **Setup** (Also Bottom Left), then choose "Show Details"

Open the Layout menu and set the Color Matching to **In Printer**



6. Return to Layout menu  
Select **Color Options**

Mode: Choose *Color* or *Grayscale* (if B&W)  
Printer Emulation: *Off*  
Uncheck: “HP Professional PANTONE Emulation”  
Default Source Profile:  
    RGB: Adobe RGB(1998)  
    CMYK: ISO Coated V2



7. Return to Layout menu  
Select **Paper/Quality**

Quality Options: Custom  
Quality: Best  
Check: Maximum Resolution for Photo Papers, Unidirectional
