### BASIC ELIGIBILITY

- Completed Bachelors or Masters degrees
- Ages 18 to 30, up to 35 for veterans
- Possess US citizenship or permanent residency
- Must undergo a government background check if selected
- Culturally identify as Hispanic/Latino
- Available to work full-time (40 hours weekly) for the entire fellowship term (11 months)
