Program Fee: A Program Fee will be applied to each student’s account by PennDesign’s Office of Student Services on January 30, 2018. Students will receive an email confirmation when the fee has been applied along with information about how to increase their loan eligibility for the spring term to cover program-related expenses, if applicable.

<p>TUITION + GENERAL FEE</p> <p>Students will receive 1 elective course unit of credit for this course within the standard spring tuition. An additional general fee will provide accommodation & select program costs, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> --Lodging (hotels) for 28 nights in Berlin, Dessau and Weimar --Local museum and site fees --Bicycle rental for full month --Train travel in sites in Germany 	<p>\$4020</p>

This course is rostered as a 1 CU spring elective. The drop deadline is January 29, 2018.

Additional Expenses

The following are additional expenses not included in the tuition/program fee. Please note that all costs are approximations. The actual cost will vary depending on the student’s spending habits, extent of personal travel and fluctuations in the exchange rate.

<p>ROUND-TRIP AIRFARE: Estimate \$1000 to \$1400 traveling from the East Coast U.S. Est. arrival/departure cost = \$35</p>
<p>LOCAL TRANSPORTATION: A local transportation pass costs roughly \$100/month</p>
<p>MEALS: Estimate \$20-50/day for lunch and dinner</p>
<p>COURSE MATERIALS Camera/IPad equipment/etc. (OPTIONAL) \$800</p>

Additional Requirements

<p>PASSPORT & VISA</p> <p>A valid passport is required. A visa is not needed for U.S. citizens. Citizens from other countries should confirm if they need a visa. Please see Sean Limlaw if you need a letter from the department to obtain your visa.</p>
<p>HEALTH INSURANCE</p> <p>Make sure you understand how your current health insurance works overseas and if necessary, purchase additional coverage. All participants are covered by Penn’s group policy with International SOS for emergency and medical assistance. This primarily provides coverage for emergency evacuation and repatriation as well as in-country medical and legal referrals. You will be provided SOS cards before departing.</p>

Travel Stipend and Financial Aid

<p>PennDesign will provide a \$1000 stipend to defray costs for graduate students in all departments. Application for financial aid for fee and additional expenses will open on January 30, 2017.</p>
