Dear Professor Dubbledam and Professor Loeffler:

After reviewing the five-year Interim Progress Report (IPR) for the Master of Architecture program submitted by University of Pennsylvania, the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB) has rejected the IPR as not having corrected or demonstrated substantial progress toward addressing deficiencies identified in the most recent two-year Interim Progress Report. SPC A.7 is still Not Met. Student work submitted for Condition II.1.1. SPC: A.7 History and Global Culture does not demonstrate achievement at the prescribed level.

Consistent with the <u>2015 *Procedures*</u>, Section 10.1.d.ii Interim Progress Reports, pages 81-82, the next accreditation visit is advanced by one calendar year, thereby shortening the term of accreditation, and is now scheduled for spring 2024. The Architecture Program Report (APR) is due September 7, 2023.

Please note that Program Annual Reports are still due annually.
