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## Facilities

Weitzman occupies seven historic buildings on Penn's verdant campus—Charles Addams Hall (1959), the Frank Furness-designed Fisher Fine Arts Library (1890), Duhring Wing (1931), the Franklin Building Annex (1945/1963), Meyerson Hall (1967), Stuart Weitzman Hall (1892; 2025), and the former Philadelphia Divinity School of the Protestant Episcopal Church (c. 1920)—as well as space at The Pennovation Works and 3420 Moravian Court.
